




New Chapter School

Class 3's News



The children in class 3 have been absolutely loving our topic of Prehistoric Life! So far we have learned all about dinosaurs, and we have learned so much information we have made our own non-fiction books full of facts. The books include features of non-fiction texts that we have been looking at in English lessons, such as a contents page, introduction page and glossary. The class are super proud of their hard work and the teachers are impressed with how well these books are looking.



In maths, Year 1 are learning all about numbers up to 50 and this week have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. The children are using practical resources and songs to support their work in their Power Maths books. Year 2 are working on division. They are using practical resources, jottings and number lines to work out division questions from their books.




In topic we have sorted dinosaurs into 3 categories – herbivore, carnivore and omnivore – which has helped our non-fiction book writing in English. We have used our DT skills to make a moving dinosaur picture where the dinosaur hatches out of the egg. This week we looked at where dinosaurs lived around the world, what type of habitats dinosaurs lived in, and what type of habitats animals around the world have today.



Our computing lessons have moved onto programming and using the app

'Scratch.' This is a free app that you could use at home too. Children have been learning how to input an algorithm, debug a program and generally having lots of fun on the app.



We have also started our PHSE lessons this half term. Children enjoy the 'calm me' section, where we listen to the chime and focus on our breathing. We are currently focusing on friendships and celebrating differences that we have.

So far, our half term has been great and we can't wait to learn more about dinosaurs before moving onto learning about the Stone Age soon.

Breakfast club term 3B June 2021

We are pleased to announce that we can finally re-open our doors for Breakfast club to all year groups. Breakfast club will recommence on Monday 7th June 2021 at 7.30am.


There will be 20 places available each day. Parents request a booking form by emailing the school office. Children will not be able to turn up without having a paid booking. For adhoc bookings parents will need to contact the office to see if there are any spaces available. Parents will need to pay for this provision via Parentpay in advance by the previous Wednesday. The cost will be £1.50 per child per day or £7.50 per child for a week.



Breakfast club will be classed as an additional bubble to the child's class bubble. As such, if a member of breakfast club were to test positive for covid, any child who had attended breakfast club within 48 hours alongside that person would have to self-isolate.

Doors will open between 7.30am – 7.40am, after this time all breakfast Club Staff will be located in the dining room, so we will be unable to accommodate late entries. Children will be given a choice of toast and 3 preserves, milk juice and water and a selection of cereals and fruits. After breakfast has been served, the children will participate in a set of activities with our PE staff.
