This term, our topic is 'Journeys' which looks at the Titanic (as a journey) but also the journey that the children will take as they come to the end of their time in primary school and embark upon pastures new at secondary school.

In art, the children have started to create individual pictures of the sinking Titanic using the technique of 'pointillism' which was founded by the artist Georges Seurat. When they have been completed, we will be sure to add them to the newsletter for everyone to see.



In Design and Technology, the children have started to design and make a cardboard boat that will fit a propellor. Once they have been made water-tight, they will launch them in water to see how propellers are used to displace the water and move the boat along. When creating her boat and propellor, Demi told the class that she liked being able to design the boat in groups and she is looking forward to adding the propellor.

In History, we have been looking at diary writing from the perspective of Eva Hart who was one of the Titanic's survivors. The children watched an interview with her, which really helped them to understand the tragic events of that fateful night. Jamie said, "I am enjoying learning about the Titanic because I can now understand what actually happened on its maiden voyage."

In English, the children have started their unit of work on newspaper reports. Earlier in the week, they were surprised by the 'appearance' of some very interesting graffiti art that had somehow been left in the school grounds. It was muddled up, but it didn't take the children long to see that the message read, Education is the Key to Success. They are now writing the introduction for a newspaper report – which is a challenge, but one they are working incredibly hard to achieve.
