Data Collection Sheets

As you are aware, we hold a data collection sheet for each child. It is important that the details we have on file are current in case of an emergency.

It is especially important that we know your child's most up to date medical history, address and emergency contact numbers.

Year 6 applications for a secondary school place (September 2022)



It is that time of the year when you should be thinking about which secondary school you wish your Year 6 child to attend from September 2022. Pupils will not automatically get a place allocated at their nearest school, so **every** parent needs to apply for a place no matter which school they are applying for. Some schools are oversubscribed, which means a late application may jeopardise your child's chances of receiving a place and you may then be allocated a place at a school which would not be a preferred choice.

The application window for secondary school applications opened on 1st September 2020 and closes at midnight on **31 October 2021**. Applications must be completed online.
