This week we have continued our topic of 'Marvellous Machines,' by going back to the 19th Century to learn about the lives of the Wright brothers and how their work with aviation changed the world as we know it. In history, we explored the lives of both Orville and Wilbur Wright, looking at their inspirations and hobbies to the creation of the Flyer 2 aeroplane. Here are some of the facts that we learnt about the Wright Brothers!

Orville and Wilbur Wright were brothers who invented the aeroplane – **Jiraiya**

The brothers loved playing with toy helicopters and watching birds when they were younger – **Sumera**


The first flight in 1903 only lasted 12 seconds – **Casey**

In 1904, the Flyer 2 was in the sky for over 5 minutes! – **Ivy**

Next, we put on our invention hats and asked ourselves that question: **What will air travel look like in the future?** From our class discussions, we thought of some amazing ideas to make travelling by plane safer, quicker and better for the world. Here are some of our creations with an explanation of our futuristic designs.



My machine is noiseless so that the community can sleep when the planes leave at night.



This plane is the quickest plane in the world. It uses rockets to fire the plane across the sky.

In science this week, we had the enquiry question of 'Which type of paper is best for flying a paper aeroplane the furthest?' We had to discuss which type of paper would be best for flying our aeroplanes and made predictions, explaining what we thought. We created a tally chart based on our predictions and compared them to Class 4. Next, we worked tirelessly to create paper aeroplanes for testing that were made of paper, card, sugar paper, tissue paper, cardboard and tracing paper. We had to create a fair test of throwing from the same place and from the same height. We won't tell you the best type of paper so why not test it yourselves at home?

In English, we started our new unit of work for description, looking at the T-shirt machine. We have created a massive bank of descriptive phrases to describe how it works, what it looks like and even what noises it makes. We are trying our hardest to up-level our vocabulary to build a greater bank to use in our writing. We can't wait to write sentences describing this amazing machine.

Year 6 applications for a secondary school place (September 2022)



It is that time of the year when you should be thinking about which secondary school you wish your Year 6 child to attend from September 2022. Pupils will not automatically get a place allocated at their nearest school, so **every** parent needs to apply for a place no matter which school they are applying for. Some schools are oversubscribed, which means a late application may jeopardise your child's chances of receiving a place and you may then be allocated a place at a school which would not be a preferred choice.

The application window for secondary school applications opened on 1st September 2020 and closes at midnight on **31 October 2021**. Applications must be completed online.
